Notice to Competitors

◆ Competitors through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry: USDAA's Official rules & regulations as amended January 1, 2002 are hereby incorporated by reference, a copy of which may be obtained by sending \$6.00 (postage & handling included) to: USDAA, P. O. Box 850955, Richardson, TX 75085-0955

◆ This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.

◆ Dogs must be registered with USDAA and provide a registration number on the entry form unless submitting the included dog registration form with entry.

◆ Following are the jump heights:

◆ No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

◆ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.

◆ The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

◆ Agility Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the Official Rules and Regulations of the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.

◆ For all Canadian Competitors: All Fees MUST be submitted in US Funds via Int'l Postal Money Order.

◆ There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event the dog and/or handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal.

◆ This event will be outside on grass. There will be adequate crating area in the vicinity of the ring. Please bring your own chair and keep in mind that shade will be at a premium, so come prepared. No unauthorized vehicles will be permitted on the field.

◆ All dogs must be held on leash or crated except when competing or while in the exercise area. Exercising of dogs is permitted in designated areas ONLY. Dog Litter Pick Up Laws are strictly enforced. Thank you for your cooperation.

◆ **Entry at this show is unlimited. If you do need to send your entry via overnight mail, please sign the release.**

◆ A Dog must compete in the height division in which they have entered except in the case where a dog is required by the judge to jump a higher height. In such case, the dog will be required to be placed at the top of the running order for that division, or may exhibit FEO at the lower height. In this case dogs running FEO will not earn qualifying scores and any and all prizes/awards will not be awarded. Otherwise, FEO entries will not be allowed.

◆ At the discretion of the organizing committee fault limits may be imposed. Classes will be run in two rings simultaneously. If a conflict arises the competitor should speak to the Gate Steward, every effort will be made to accommodate each competitor's ring schedule.

Dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. A registration card and number with a "U" prefix will be issued to facilitate entry at USDAA events and tracking of show results in the regular classes. Junior handlers (those 18 years of age and younger) and their dogs must be separately registered for participation in the USDAA's Junior Handler Program (UJHP). A registration number with a "j" prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A dog that is expected to compete in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program. If registering for both programs at the same time, the total fee is \$28.00.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

FDR Park is off the Taconic State Parkway, approximately 18 miles south of Route I-84

Note—commercial vehicles/Trailers/RV's ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE TACONIC.

Note: There is a \$5.00 car parking fee charged by FDR Park each day and \$10.00 RV parking fee each day.

Passenger Cars:

From the North or South: Taconic State Parkway to FDR Exit.

From the West: Tappan Zee Bridge to Route 287 (Cross Westchester Expressway) Take Saw Mill River Parkway North to the Taconic State Parkway to FDR Park.

From the East: I-684 to Route 35 West (Katonah). *Make left onto Route 35 and go into Yorktown. In center of town (just after the Triangle Shopping Center) turn right onto Route 202. Continue on Route 202 to FDR Park on your left*

Commercial Vehicles:

From the North: I-684 South to Route 35 West (Katonah) *Follow as underlined above.

From the South: I-684 North to Route 35 West (Katonah) *Follow as underlined above.

USDAA®

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® Local Qualifier

This class is open to all dogs regardless of title or skill level — a single-rounded tournament featuring the sport in its basic form. The course includes an a-frame, dog walk, or cross-over, see-saw, pipe tunnel, collapsed tunnel, weave poles, tire jump and a variety of other jumps and hurdles. Scoring follows regulations for standard scoring under Masters rules, except that time standards may generally range from 3.50 yards per second to 3.75 yards per second for dogs competing in the 22" and 26" height classes and from 2.85 to 3.00 per second in the 12' height class and from 3.00 to 3.25 yards per second for dogs competing in the 16" height class.

Dogs that earn seven (7) or fewer faults (combined course and time penalties) shall qualify to enter one of the Regional championship events. Two (2) qualifying rounds of seven (7) faults or less (one of which may be earned at the Regional Championship) are required for entry to the World Championship quarterfinals. A complete copy of the 2003 tournament rules, which are hereby incorporated by reference, will be posted at the event or may be obtained directly from USDAA.

If your dog is entered in the Performance Program at this event then you must fill out a separate entry  form for the Grand Prix.

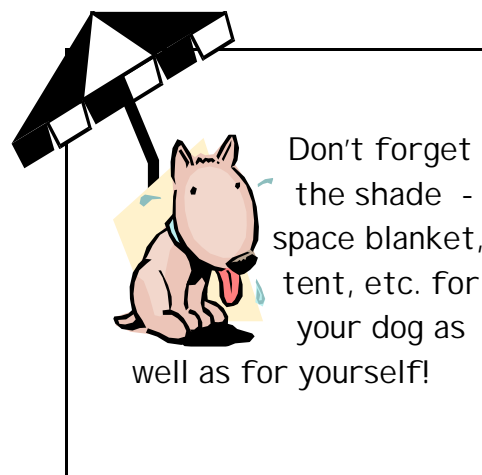

Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of returned check if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any

unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse.

◆ All competitors through entry to this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, all competitors and handlers hereby grant to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of personality, or any similar right.

Program Descriptions

Championship Dog Agility Program

The Championship Program classes are for dogs not entered in the Performance Program at this event. Classes include standard agility, gamblers, jumpers, pairs relay and snooker agility as set forth in USDAA rules and regulations, each of which are conducted at three competitive levels, as listed below:

The **Starter/Novice** level classes shall be for any dogs that have not earned the *Agility Dog®* title. When offered separately as Starters and Novice classes, the starters level classes are for dogs that have also not earned a title in the Performance Program, or a dog that is handled by a person who has not previously earned the *Agility Dog®* title or a title in the Performance or Veterans Program with any dog.

The **Advanced** level classes shall be for dogs that have earned the *Agility Dog®* title and have not earned the *Advanced Agility Dog®* title.

The **Masters** level classes shall be for dogs that have earned the *Advanced Agility Dog®* title. Additionally, a dog that has received two qualifying scores in one Advanced level nonstandard agility class (i.e., Snooker, Jumpers, Gamblers or Pairs Relay), with scores being earned from two different judges (and with two different partners in pairs relay), shall be eligible for entry into the same Masters level nonstandard class without having earned the *Advanced Agility Dog®* title.

Performance Program Classes

Performance Program classes are open to dogs **not entered** in the

Championship Dog Agility Program at this agility test. Classes include standard performance, gamblers performance, jumpers performance and snooker performance classes as defined in USDAA rules & regulations. Generally, Performance Level I, Level II and Level III are run on courses used for Starters, Advanced and Masters classes in the Championship Program, with the following exceptions: the A-frame is set at 5'6", jump heights are one height class lower as set forth in Notes to Exhibitors, no spread hurdles are utilized and time standards in the standard and jumpers classes are extended by 3 seconds beyond that utilized in the Championship Program. Eligibility for entry is determined as follows:

The **Performance I** classes shall be for any dog that has not earned the *Performance Dog ™* title.

The **Performance II** classes shall be for any dog that has earned the *Performance Dog®* title, the *Agility Dog* title or the *Veteran Agility Dog®* title, but has not earned the *Performance Dog II™* title.

The **Performance III** classes shall be for any dog that has earned the *Performance Dog II™* title, the *Advanced Agility Dog* title, or the *Veteran Advanced Agility Dog®* title. Additionally, a dog that has received two qualifying scores from two different judges in either (1) two qualifying scores in Level II nonstandard classes, (2) two qualifying scores in Advanced level nonstandard classes, or (3) two qualifying scores in Veterans level non standard classes.

Non-Standard Class Descriptions

Gamblers Class - consists of a course with no pre-determined route and each obstacle is assigned a point value. In the 'opening' period the handler seeks to accumulate points by performing the obstacles of his/her choice in the time allotted. At the conclusion of the 'opening' the handler attempts the 'gamble', a sequence designated by the judge to be handled from a distance, for additional points. This non-standard class is pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations.

Pairs Class - The handlers shall carry a baton throughout the course, passing it from one handler to another at the designated passing area as each dog runs the course in turn. This non-standard class is scored pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations

Open Pairs

This non-titling pairs class is

open to Starters/Novice and all levels of Performance dogs. This class will be run under Starters/Novice rules on a Starters/Novice course. No spread hurdles shall be used and the A-frame shall be set at 5'6". Any additional rules will be described by the judge on the day of the game.

Snooker Class has an 'opening' sequence of point collection similar to the Gamblers followed by a closing sequence of a set pattern. Roughly parallels the billiards game of 'Snooker', requiring the dog to successfully complete a 'red' jump prior to attempting an obstacle designated as any other color. This non-standard class is scored pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations.

Jumpers Class - consists of a course of jumps and may include a tire and tunnels. This non-standard class is scored pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of the USDAA Rules and Regulations.

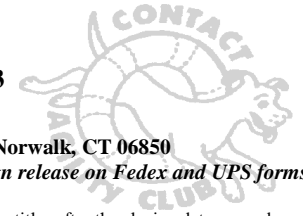

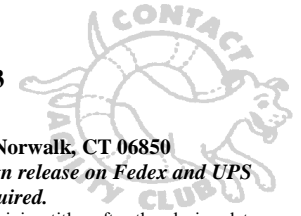

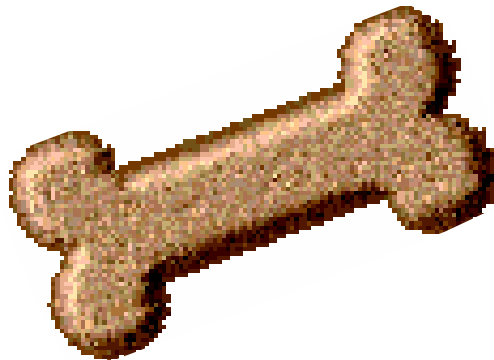
